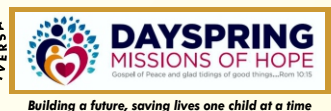

A letter from the President



Friends,

I count it a great privilege to serve in God's Vineyard and a great joy and blessing it has been to love, to hold and to serve God's Children in need in different nations of the world.

For 16 years now on the Mission field, (6 years with other Missionary Organization and 10 years with Dayspring Missions), I have responded to the dictates of the word of God in Matthew 28:19-20 that commands every believer to go into the uttermost parts of the world and preach the gospel, teaching them to observe all things Jesus has commanded. So as we celebrate the 10th Anniversary of our Missionary Organization - the Dayspring Missions of Hope, I count it a privilege indeed to be used of God not only as an Advocate for the poor and needy Children, but also as a preacher to men and

women and particularly as a Counselor to Inmates at various jails and prisons both here in the United States as well as in other Countries.

Starting with the Orange County Jail and Prison Ministries in the State of Florida, I have been privileged to be a part of, as a volunteer preacher since April 2003 and have shared the word of God to thousands of Inmates at the 33rd street jail facility, the Work-Release jail facility both in Orlando, the women Prison at Riverview Florida, counting with Male and Female Prisons in Malawi, Africa.

I thank God for this great opportunity to preach the gospel to the Inmates at these facilities with countless number of souls coming to the knowledge of Christ, for the joy and grace of still being able to share the word and the love of Christ with God's Children in various schools we have visited on the Mission field. What a joy this has been!

In all the years that I have traveled to these different nations, I have seen and held children who are without families and who beg to be carried away to "wherever you go". I have seen children who pick up crumbs from the dirt, not knowing where the next crumbs will come from. I have seen children walking over 20 miles daily to far away communities just to get education. I have been shown little girls (10-12 years of age) who are said to be 'married' because there are no schools around for them to attend. In all the countries visited, I have grieved as children become cynical about their future as poverty robs them of childhood hopes and expectations.

But these stories alone are not the full picture. Thank God that I have also seen thousands of children's faces light up as we tell them Jesus loves them despite their sufferings, as we share school bags and various other humanitarian goods with them. I have seen young teenage girls scream for joy as we bring hygiene education to their schools and also the washable sanitary wares (courtesy - the Days for Girls Int.). Most importantly, I have prayed and worshiped with thousands and thousands of children who have new views of life today - and life in eternity through a relationship with Jesus Christ.

Perhaps the biggest steps of Faith we have taken as a Ministry is the Village School we are helping to build in a Community in Malawi. We are believing God that the Lord that started this project shall perfect it as we look forward to commissioning the School this year 2020 by His grace.

The next few pages will open up to you our heart for ministry to the poor and needy children, the joy of reaching out to the battered and neglected rural women, the village elders men and women, the Inmates languishing in African Prisons, the neglected and almost totally forgotten men and women living in Old Peoples homes and much more. The pages will also open up to you the progress on the village school project, our accomplishments as a team and goals for the future. Thank you for your support

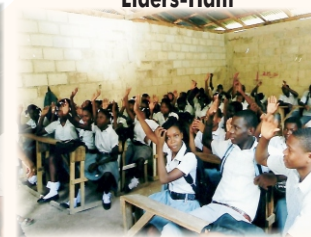

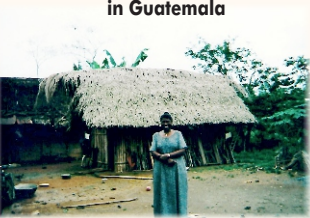

Arms of the Dayspring Ministry

1. THE EVANGELICAL:- This is the core of our Ministry. Taking the word to the World through personal involvement as Jesus commanded us in Mark 16:15-16 to go into all the world preaching the gospel to every creature (i.e to:Children, Men, Women, Youth, Prisoners, every creature everywhere).

This commandment has been the force that has been propelling us into action and this we shall continue to do till the day of His return.

2. (a) The Care Ministry:- Caring and Ministering to the Elders in the Community. We visit and share the word and love of Christ with the elders - men and women whether they live at home or in assisted living facilities. Reaching out to them has been a thing of joy to our hearts!

(b). The Care For The Orphans and sharing the love of Christ with God's precious children and their caregivers is something we love to do on the Mission Field. Not only do we preach the word of God, we reach out to them in materials that are needful for the body as Jesus commanded. (James 2:15-16)

© **THE FEEDING PROGRAM:-** The Bible says: Everywhere Jesus went, He was doing good (Acts 10:38). Jesus fed the Multitudes on two separate occasions (Mark 6:31-44, Matt. 14:13-21). In each of these miracle feeding, Jesus fed 5,000 and 4,000 when the people were hungry. We also do like when Children come to listen to the word of God, we do not send them away hungry but feed thousands and thousands of them on a daily basis the physical food after they have been fed with the word of God. To God be the glory!

(3) The Prison Ministry:- For over 16 years now, (even before Dayspring Missions was birthed) the jail and prison ministries have been one area the Lord has used us tremendously in winning souls to His Kingdom. We thank God that from April 2003 till present, thousands of souls have been won to the kingdom of God. What a joy it brings to the heart - when sometimes at a Gas Station, in Shopping malls, restaurants, in Churches, someone taps you on the back and tells you - "I know you, God used you to change my life, You led me to Christ while I was at the jail, I am now a saved and born again Christian" To Him alone be the glory!



(4)(a). Education Ministry:- Next to winning souls for the Kingdom of God, education is one area we show God's love for His Children. The Bible says in the book of Hosea 4:6 "My people perish for lack of Knowledge". Illiteracy is a serious disease and without education a life is in total darkness. It is a life without form, and without illumination and such life is totally undesirable. This Ministry believes so much in education, that is why we are trying our best to help wipe out as much as we can this serious disease of illiteracy, and with the help from God, we took a giant step of Faith to help build a school in a community in Malawi where there is no school.



(b) Hygiene Education:- We added this to our Mission's itinerary by partnering with the 'Days for Girls International'. It was this Organization that brought the plight of young teenage girls who have no access to Hygiene products for their monthly menstrual cycle to limelight. They came up with the washable sanitary wares for the girls. Since the advent of this wonderful product (in a Kit), life has changed dramatically for majority of these teenage girls in rural areas, as they no longer have to miss 7 days of school every month like before. On the Mission Field, we educate the girls on the need for proper hygiene and also distribute the DFG sanitary kits to them.



The joy this wonderful product brings to the heart of every beneficiary teenage girl is better imagined! It has been such an honor and privilege to minister both to the young and the old in various places listed above - from the rural areas of Argentina (have been there over and over again), to Haiti, Malawi and other nations. I have enjoyed the privilege the Lord has given to meet and share the Love of Jesus with various indigenous Pastors, Wives of Pastors through organized conferences, men, women and God's precious children in all these nations.

What a joy! What an honor and what a privilege to serve!. We return all the glory to our Heavenly Father.



Accomplishments & Goals for the Future

As we celebrate the Dayspring Missions of Hope 10th Anniversary, we take a moment to reflect on God's goodness towards us these past 10 years and beyond, and we conclude that - God indeed has been very good to us, we celebrate today the goodness and the faithfulness of God for all that He has enabled us to do within these years:

- * Since inception to date and in all the Countries visited, (Haiti, Malawi and other nations) we have shared the word of God with over 200,000 School Children (in High Schools, middle and elementary schools) and have distributed among the children, thousands of school bags, soap From Clean the World Organization, and various other humanitarian goods too numerous to mention.
- * We have preached the gospel in several Churches with men and women in many Countries, lives have been blessed and souls won to the Kingdom of God.
- * We have fed over 100,000 Children in both Malawi and Haiti since we started the feeding program.
- * We have reached out to the Elders in the remote villages of Malawi, in Assisted Living Facility and in hard-to-reach mountainous areas of Haiti.
- * We have visited the Orphanage facility in Haiti, have shared the word and the love of Christ with the orphans and their caregivers and donated various humanitarian goods to the facility.
- * We have taken Hygiene Education to Schools in Malawi and have shared sanitary products among teenage girls (courtesy - DFG Int'l) as well as brand new dresses (courtesy - the DIH sewing group, Orlando). All these items have brought a lot of joy and relief to the young teenage girls who have for so long been neglected. As we continue in this care ministry, we are helping to restore hope and dignity to these young girls.
- * On an annual or semi-annual basis depending on how many trips we are able to make in a year, we organize Empowerment Conferences for both the Urban and the Rural women. During such conferences, women are taught on how to be financially independent by using their God given talents to earn some reasonable amount of money to support their families. We share the word of God with them on how to keep their family together and raise Godly family.
- * One other Annual Program we run that has proved so beneficial and which has touched so many lives positively is our Girls Conference : I AM A GIRL AND NOT A BRIDE. Since we included this program in our itinerary every year, it was an Instant Success. It is to enlighten the girls who have either by themselves by reasons of low self esteem sold themselves out cheaply to older men, but in most cases by greedy, selfish and naive parents who for some temporary financial gains give these girls away in 'marriage' at ages 12 - 14 years of age. We work in partnership with the local women Village Chiefs who work tirelessly to rescue thousands of these girls from such marriages and send them back to school. It is a thing of joy to our hearts that with the little help we render as a team, lives of these girls are being changed and destinies turned around to the glory of God.
- * Because of the closeness of Haiti to the United States, we have been able to organize annual Christmas parties to the Elders in Assisted Living Facility in Haiti who have almost been totally forgotten and abandoned both physically and spiritually. We go to this facility turning a gloomy and hopeless atmosphere to a vibrant and lively one. words of God are shared, meals are prepared, gifts are packaged and a dance party organized with a DJ stand.



- * Haiti Children love our Christmas Parties! We usually ship loads of toys ahead of time to Haiti and distribute to every child different kinds of toys and of course, after feeding them with spiritual food, kids are served delicious meals while the DJ plays the music.
- * Perhaps the biggest giant step of Faith we have taken as a Ministry is the present project we are on now we are helping to build a secondary school in Kalambo, Malawi for the little children who have been walking 22 miles (both ways) daily to the nearest School to their community. This is because there is no Secondary School for them to attend in their own community. It takes them 3 hours to walk to school and 3 hours to return home. The 6 hours daily walk becomes only 15 minutes when school is completed. What a huge difference this school will make and what a big relief it will be for these little children!
- * We want to thank God for all He has enabled us to accomplish with in this not-too-long period as a Ministry as we look up to Him for the greater things He will yet empower us to do in the years ahead. To God alone be all the glory.

Goals for the Future

- * Our major goal this year is to complete the - KALAMBO SECONDARY SCHOOL project the Lord has placed in our hands to do in Malawi. The project was to have been completed two years ago but for the reason of the relocation of the President of this Ministry after the loss of the spouse which literally disrupted the plans and put the project on hold for a while. We however thank God at this time for the renewal of strength to continue the good work and believing God for a speedy completion of the project.
- * As mentioned earlier, the school when completed will bring education to the doorstep of the children that live in this community. A 6-hour daily walk will be reduced to only 15 minutes! That's how close the school is to the children.

*Our goal to complete the school by the special grace and enablement from God at the end of this year 2020 and hand it over to the Department of Education in Malawi to administer. However, our Ministry will continue to support the school with donation of school supplies, computers, teaching Aids etc., and in whatever form we possibly can till Jesus returns.

*We will continue with all the areas of accomplishments - with Evangelism, the Caregiving, the Jail and Prison Ministration, School Ministration etc., Since there is no retirement in Kingdom work, we shall continue to do all by His grace, according to the dictates and guidance of

- * The other Mission work we do side by side with Malawi School Project is the help we render to the Old People's home in Petit-Goave, Haiti. This facility and the Residents need a lot of help. It is our prayer that some Churches out there, God Spirited individuals or other Non-Profit Organizations will rise up to help turn around the living conditions of this very pathetic place thereby restoring joy and dignity to the elders that live in there.
- * As we can see, the Harvest indeed is plentiful, but the laborers are few (Matthew 9:37) Please pray along with us that the God of wonder and the God of Harvest will bring in the needed helpers into all the harvest fields where help is needed.
- * We thank our Almighty God for the opportunity He has given us as a team to serve in His vineyard. Hallelujah!
